

Waste Discharge Requirements For Napa County Wineries

- 1. The winery is required to monitor Dissolved Oxygen (DO), pH, Freeboard and Odor in and around the wastewater treatment pond on a weekly basis.
- 2. The winery is required to monitor Biological Oxygen Demand (BOD), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Settleable Solids (SS) and flow in and from the wastewater treatment pond on a monthly basis.
- 3. The winery is required to generate self monitoring reports on a monthly basis. These reports must contain the information required as stated above.
- 4. The winery is required to submit a quarterly self monitoring report to Napa County Department of Environmental Management.
- 5. The winery is prohibited from land applying treated wastewater unless the following conditions are met:
 - A. BOD less than 50 ppm
 - B. TSS less than 50 ppm.
 - C. pH no less than 6.0 and no greater than 9.0
 - D. DO no less than 1.0 ppm
